

Background:

As you are aware, Governor Abbott issued an Executive Order GA – 40 dated October 11, 2021, that states:

“No entity in Texas can compel receipt of a COVID-19 vaccine by any individual, including an employee or a consumer, who objects to such vaccination for any reason of personal conscience, based on a religious belief, or for medical reasons, including prior recovery from COVID-19. I hereby suspend all relevant statutes to the extent necessary to enforce this prohibition”

A few weeks ago, President Biden made a statement that all children in schools would be vaccinated.

Even though I believe what he intended is being taken out of context, I have been receiving emails and a few calls regarding the official stance of the school on the COVID Vaccine. Some have even questioned if we would vaccinate their children without the knowledge of the parent.

Because of this, I feel that we need to have an official statement when people ask and that this statement needs to have the blessing of the Board to ensure that we are all on the same page.

COVID Vaccine Statement

Round Rock Christian Academy will not require that the COVID -19 vaccine be taken by any employee, student, or volunteer. We believe that this vaccine (as well as other vaccines) should be a personal choice for each person (family) to make in their best interest.

If at such time that the State requires this vaccine for school attendance, RRCA will work with families to file the proper exemption request with the State if they desire.
