



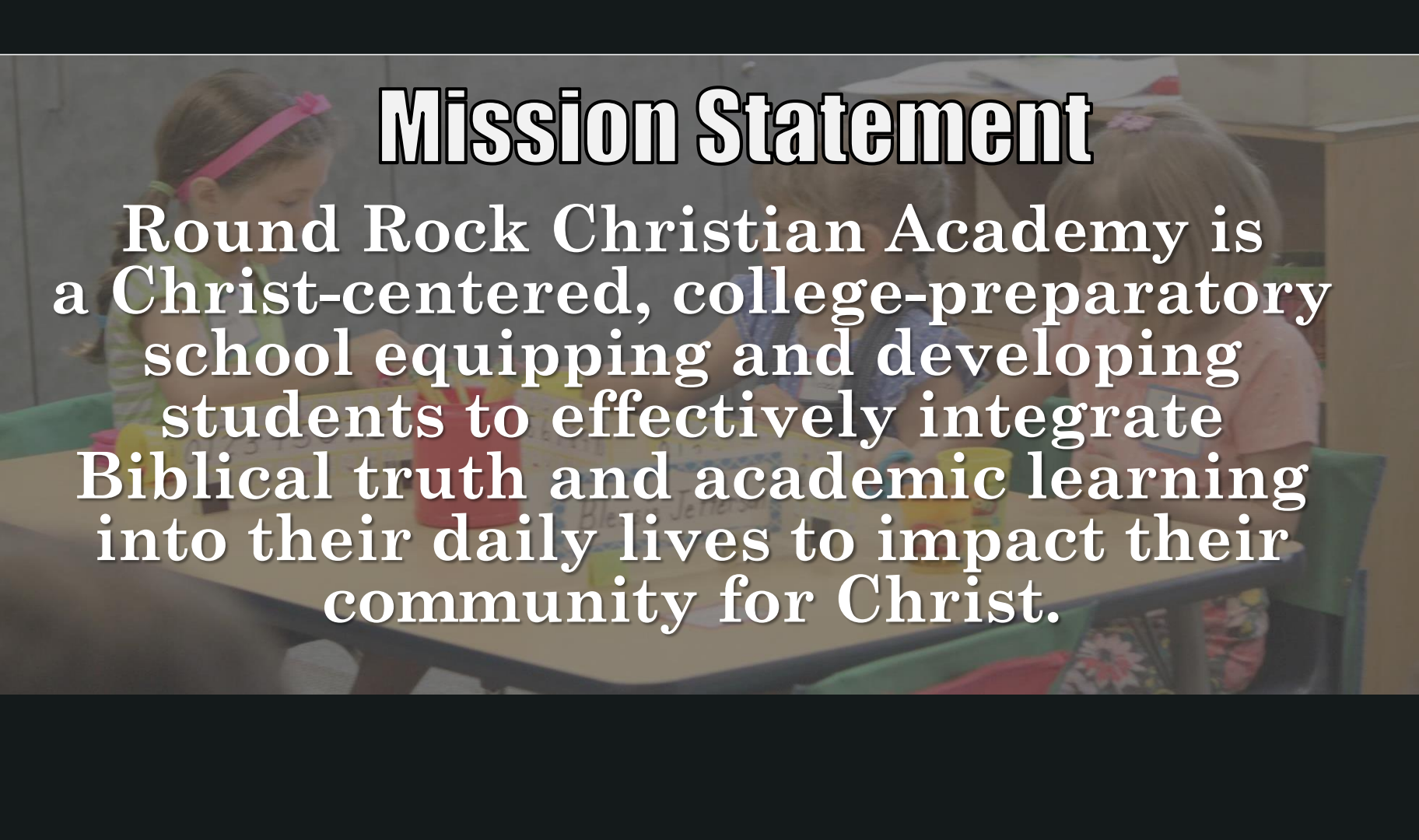

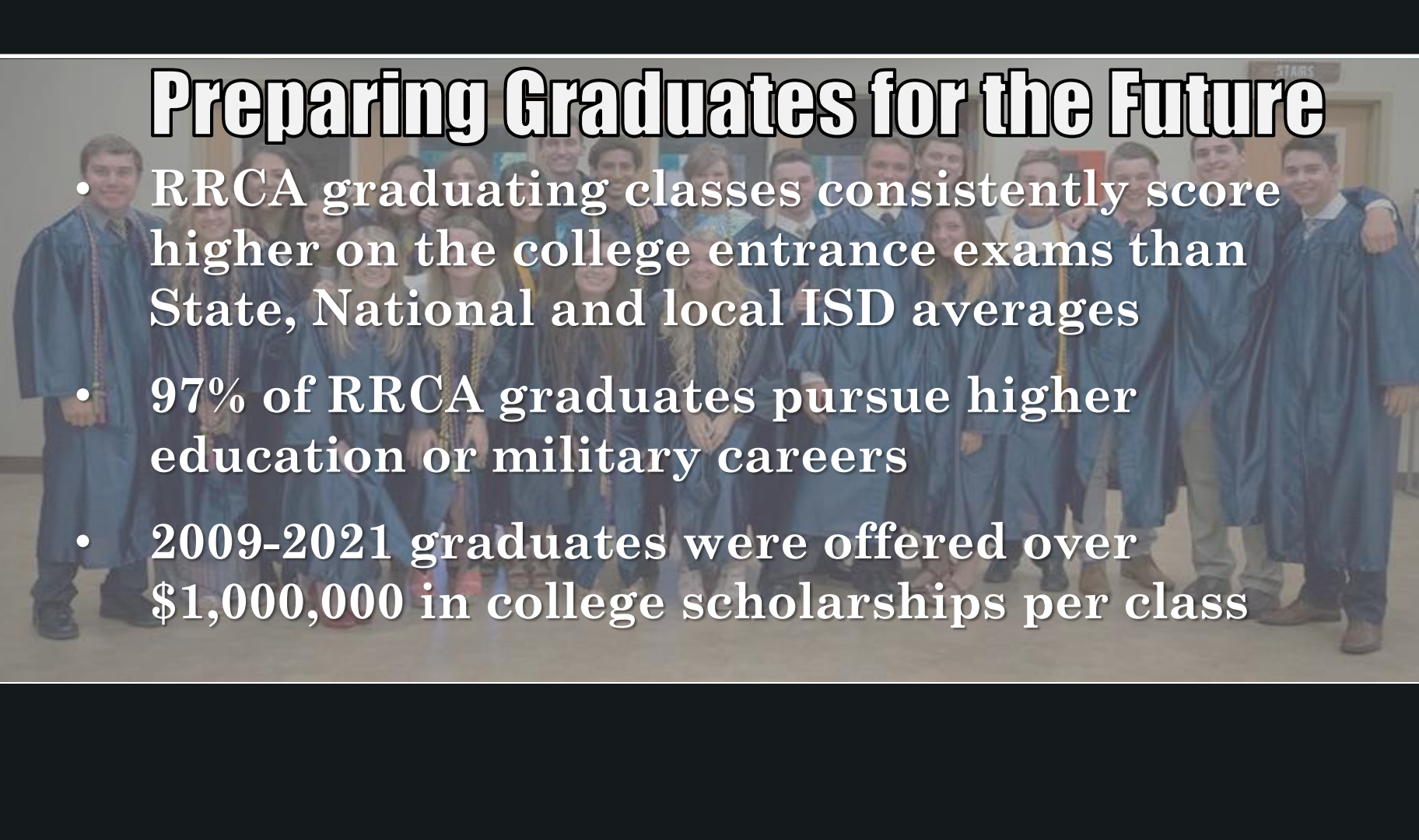

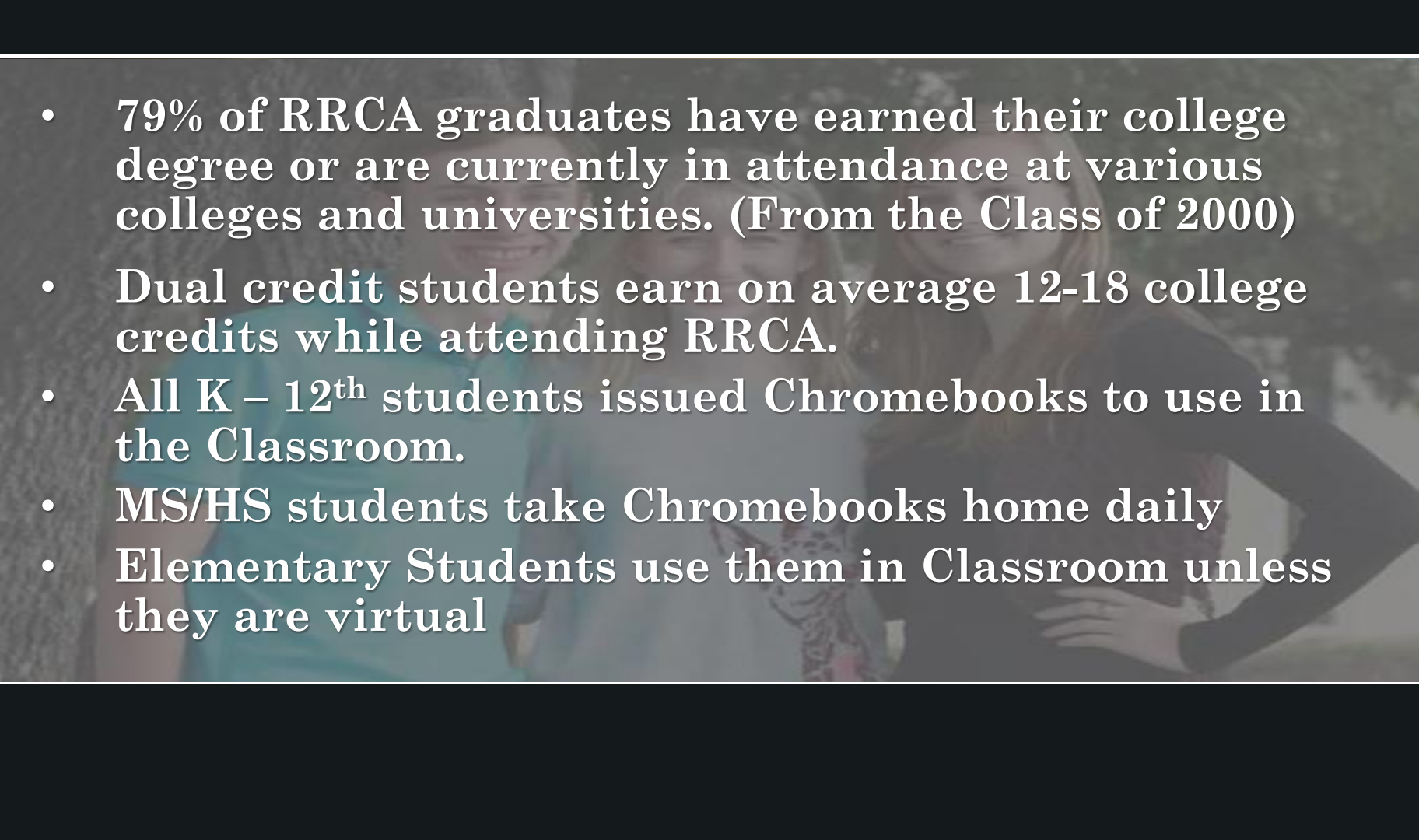
Pursuing Excellence

- Approximately 92% of high school students participate in athletics or fine arts.

- RRCA graduating classes consistently score higher on the college entrance exams than State, National and local ISD averages
- 97% of RRCA graduates pursue higher education or military careers
- 2009-2021 graduates were offered over \$1,000,000 in college scholarships per class

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- 79% of RRCA graduates have earned their college degree or are currently in attendance at various colleges and universities. (From the Class of 2000)
 - Dual credit students earn on average 12-18 college credits while attending RRCA.
 - All K – 12th students issued Chromebooks to use in the Classroom.
 - MS/HS students take Chromebooks home daily
 - Elementary Students use them in Classroom unless they are virtual

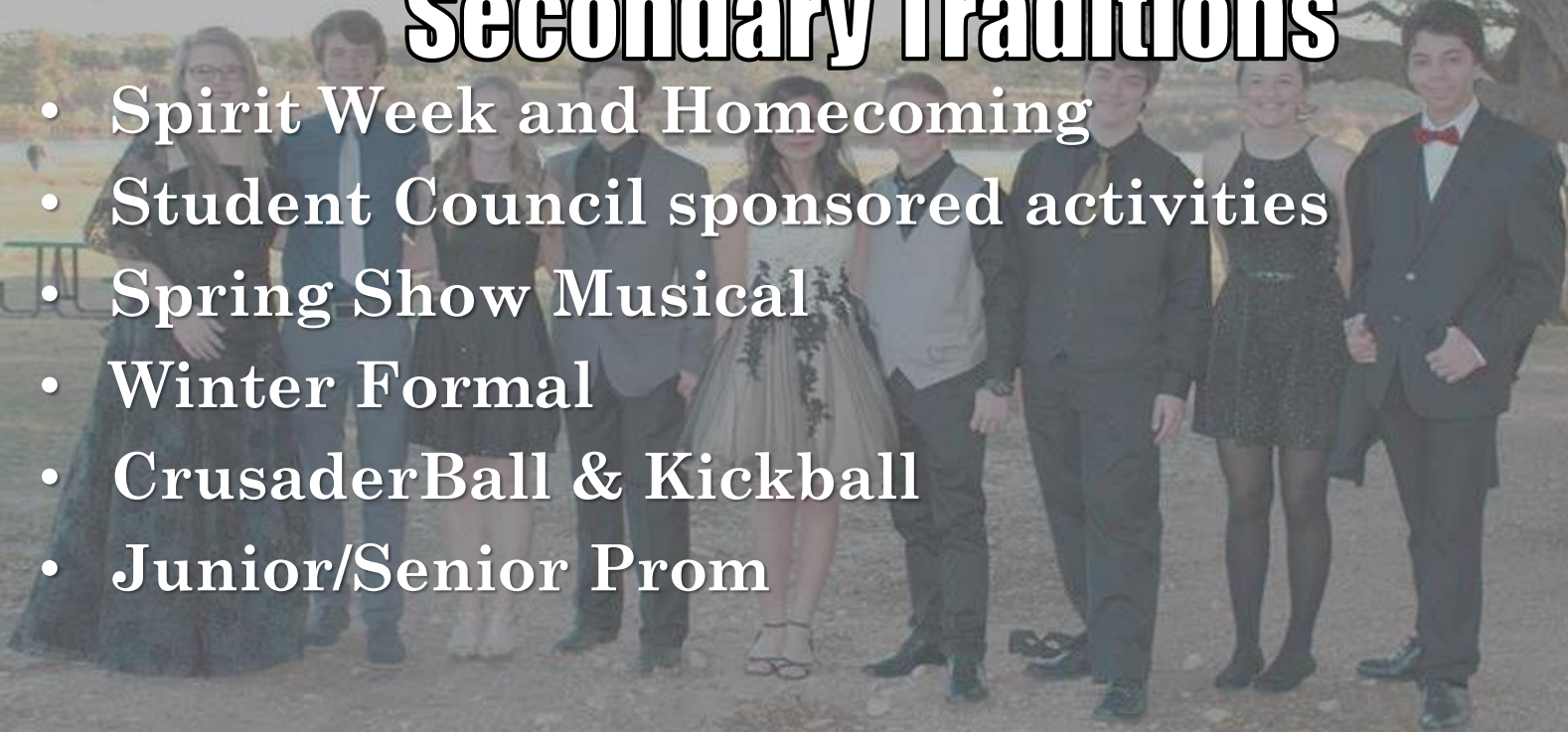

Campus Security Precautions

- Raptor badging system for visitors
- 80 plus Security cameras in classrooms, hallways, playgrounds and building exterior
- Secured access to building
- All Visitors check in through one access point

COVID Protocols

- Masks are optional for staff, students and parents
- COVID Positive Cases quarantine for 5 days
- Cases in the household currently quarantine for 5 days
- Close contact notifications are made
(Parents are given the choice to keep their child home for 5 days or to attend school)

- RRCA participates in the school COVID testing program

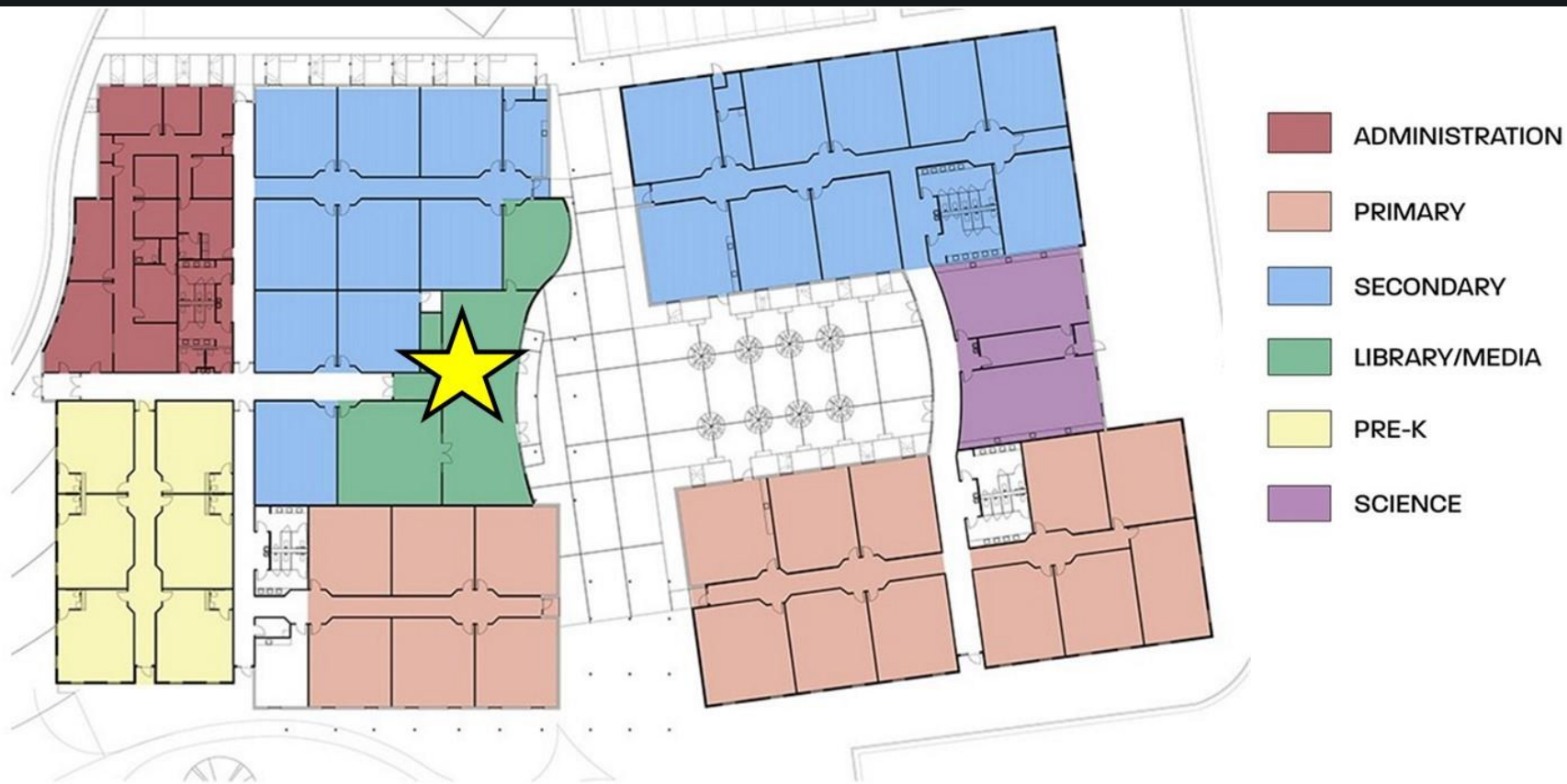
