

Wait Pool

A wait pool consists of all of the ‘approved’ students for each grade, without any ranking. If a spot opens up, the admissions committee reconvenes to review the students again to determine who is offered the spot.

Priority of Admission

Students who have siblings enrolled at RRCA have priority at early enrollment each year. All other applications are prioritized by the date on the application, and new student and registration fees are received by the Admissions Office. If no spots are available, qualified applicants will be placed in a wait pool.

If an opening becomes available, the admission committee will review applications to determine which candidate is the best fit for RRCA. The school reserves the right to give priority consideration to qualified siblings and alumni child applicants.
